## EQUIP | 2026 Launch of Leadership Lab

In the kick-off of 2026 Leadership Lab Series, Pastor Øystein Gjerme from Salt in Bergen, Norway shared insights on preaching effectively in today's secular culture—keeping the gospel uncompromised while building bridges for skeptics to explore faith.

Gjerme challenged theme-based preaching, urging a return to text-driven teaching that forms Bible-reading churches. He recommended clear "big ideas" repeated throughout sermon series and reinforced through small groups discussing the Sunday text.

Practically, he encouraged preachers to write messages to avoid rambling, guard their tone and nonverbal communication, and plan around seasonal rhythms with long-term discipleship outcomes in mind.
