THEOLOGY 101



In 2026 OFN launched a new initiative aimed at increasing the depth of theology for those ministers who are already vocationally serving. The Tour of Theology led by Jack Groblewski is a 10-month intensive study of the core theology beliefs of the church. The first cohort of 12 students from 9 churches and 2 countries is learning together about the irreplaceable value of theology in every ministry of a local church.

2026 PTI REPORT



The Pastoral Training Intensive is a signature event. At the heart of everything we do is a simple conviction: **healthy leaders build healthy churches**. PTI is where that conviction becomes reality, as pastors step away from the demands of ministry to be poured into, refreshed, and equipped for the long road of shepherding their churches well.

In July, in the **Beartooth Mountains of Montana**, two separate men's PTIs gathered pastors to hike, ride horseback, pray, and sit under rich teaching from **Dan Backens, Brian Weaver and Andrew Cromwell**. But ask any of them what mattered most, and you'll hear the same answer: the relationships — real conversations, real questions, real wisdom exchanged between brothers.

Our women leaders gathered this year in June in San Diego, where **Tina Davis** led them in a rich impartation of spiritual formation. The women's PTI carries special significance: women in church leadership face unique challenges, and OFN places a high value on raising up strong, equipped women leaders to serve in every area of our church ministries. And in an exciting first, in May we partnered with Trefpunkt Leben and New Life Church Frankfurt to host a **PTI in Germany** for German pastors — extending this investment in healthy leaders across the ocean.

This year, **35 pastors and leaders** from churches across the network experienced PTI. These aren't conferences. They're family — time set apart for shepherds to be shepherded, so they can return home strengthened to lead.
